purposes. <u>On or before February 1, 1994 the commissioner shall</u> adopt rules for approving lease costs for school buildings as defined in section 15603, subsection 8, paragraph B and for determining the amount includable for subsidy purposes.

Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §15905, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1989, c. 911, §10, is further amended to read:

4. Rules. The state board may adopt or amend rules 10 relating to the approval of school construction projects.

12 The state board is encouraged to review school construction rules regarding costs per square foot, consider other measures for 14 containing building costs and report on these efforts to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction 16 over education matters during the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature. <u>On or before February 1, 1994 the state board</u> 18 <u>shall adopt rules for approving movable equipment costs for school construction.</u>

## FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Education will incur some minor additional 24 costs to adopt rules related to school building lease costs. These costs can be absorbed within the Department's existing 26 budgeted resources.

28 The additional costs to adopt rules for approving movable equipment for school construction projects can be absorbed by the 30 State Board of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment clarifies 36 that the Director of the Bureau of General Services may refuse to release plans and specifications to a contractor for the purpose 38 of bidding on a public works project if, in the opinion of the director, the contractor has not completed prior construction 40 projects in a timely manner or if the contractor has a history of inability to complete similar projects.

The amendment directs the Commissioner of Education to adopt rules for approval of lease costs for school buildings and for determining what portion of the costs may be eligible for state subsidy. The amendment also directs the State Board of Education to adopt rules for approving movable equipment costs for school construction projects and adds a fiscal note.
