Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §63, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

6 5. Design and issuance of identification bracelets. The
8 commission shall authorize a design for, and issue, an
10 identification bracelet to any minor under 21 years of age
12 requesting such a bracelet. The bracelet allows the minor entry
14 into a Class A lounge as provided in section 1065, subsection 4,
16 paragraph C.

18 Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §1065, sub-§4, ¶¶A and B, as enacted by PL
20 1987, c. 342, §90, are amended to read:

22 A. The minor is accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or
24 custodian as defined in Title 22, section 4002; ~~or~~

26 B. The licensee does not permit consumption of liquor on
28 the premises for a specific period of time or event; or

30 Sec. 3. 28-A MRSA §1065, sub-§4, ¶C is enacted to read:

C. The minor is wearing a commission-approved bracelet as
 provided in section 63, subsection 5.

STATEMENT OF FACT

 This bill provides for a bracelet approved by the State
Liquor Commission for issuance to minors that will allow the
minors entry into Class A lounges.
