COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 203, L.D. 639, Bill, "An Act to Make Corrections to the Salary Reductions Authorized in Public Law 1991, Chapter 780, Part III"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. PL 1991, c. 780, Pt. III, §1 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

This section does not apply to represented employees of the University of Maine System, nonrepresented faculty department chairs of the University of Maine System and full-time faculty of the University of Maine School of Law.

Sec. 2. PL 1991, c. 780, Pt. III, §2 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

This section does not apply to represented employees of the University of Maine System, nonrepresented faculty department chairs of the University of Maine System and full-time faculty of the University of Maine School of Law.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

Restoring the 3% and 2% salary adjustments to represented employees and to certain nonrepresented employees of the University of Maine System will result in increased costs, which can be absorbed within existing resources of the University of Maine System.'

6 The original bill unintentionally included employees of the
8 Maine Maritime Academy covered by a collective bargaining
10 agreement in the group of employees to be exempted from salary
adjustments mandated by Public Law 1991, chapter 780. The
exemption would have resulted in unbudgeted costs to the Maine
Maritime Academy of \$16,000.

14 The amendment excludes represented employees of the Maine
Maritime Academy from the list of employees who are exempted from
the provisions of Public Law 1991, chapter 780. The amendment
also adds a fiscal note.
