16 18	Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
20	FISCAL NOTE
22	This bill establishes a new Class E crime. Sentences imposed for Class E offenses must be served in a county jail.
24	The average cost per sentence for a Class E crime is \$4,188 based upon an average length of stay of 67 days. The additional costs
26	to the counties for the housing of each offender sentenced under this new crime will not require reimbursement by the State.
28	The additional workload and administrative costs associated
30	with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
32	Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenues by a minor amount.
34	The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur
36	some minor additional costs to enforce this prohibition. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted
38	resources.'
