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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 490, L.D. 648, Bill, "An Act to Require That the Inspection and Investigation Responsibilities of the Electricians' Examining Board Receive Funding Priority"

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Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

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'An Act to Allow the Inspection and Investigation Responsibilities of the Electricians' Examining Board to Receive Funding Priority'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1154." by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 8 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

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'All fees received by the board shall must be paid to the Treasurer of State. The Treasurer of State shall place the money to the credit of the Electricians' Examining Board fund. All amounts paid into this fund must be held subject to the order of the board to be used only for earrying-out the purpose of this chapter. Any balance of these fees shall may not lapse, but shall must be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years. The board shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business legislation matters when the funding or staffing provided to the board is inadequate to meet its inspection and investigation responsibilities.'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

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'FISCAL NOTE

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	Depending on the costs of inspections and investigation
4	conducted by the Electricians' Examining Board, this bill may
	reduce General Fund revenues collected through the Statewide Cos
6	Allocation Program and dedicated revenues to the Department of
	Professional and Financial Regulation collected through the
8	Direct Cost Allocation Program. The amounts can not be
	determined at this time. The annual loss of General Fund revenue
10	could be as high as \$6,856 beginning in fiscal year 1993-94.'

16	This is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee
	on Business Legislation.
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	Currently, the Commissioner of Professional and Financia
20	Regulation has authority over the budget of the Electricians
	Examining Board. The bill requires that the commissioner give
22	funding priority to the inspection and investigation
	responsibilities of the board. This amendment removes authorit
24	over the budget from the commissioner and places it with the
	board.
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The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
