2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7104-A is enacted to read:**

6 **§7104-A. Prohibition against charging fees**

8 A landowner or landowner's agent may not charge a fee for
10 any game harvested on land that is not currently licensed under
12 section 7104.

14 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§17-A is enacted to read:**

16 **17-A. Game-harvesting fee.** A landowner or landowner's
18 agent is guilty of a violation of section 7104-A if that person
20 charges a fee for any game harvested on land not licensed as a
22 commercial shooting area.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill makes it illegal for a landowner to charge a fee
for harvesting game on the landowner's land if the land is not
licensed as a commercial shooting area.
