STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment simplifies the language of the original bill.
The amendment permits agency liquor stores to deliver liquor to
establishments that are licensed for the sale of liquor on
premises. The amendment also permits on-premise licensees to
purchase liquor from any state liquor store or any agency store
regardless of the licensed establishment's distance from a state
liquor store.

The amendment also clarifies that the price of spirits sold under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28-A, section 606, subsection 1-A is equal to the price of spirits sold at state liquor stores. An agency liquor store and an on-premise licensee shall each retain a copy of the licensee order form upon completion of a transaction.
