16 This bill establishes a Maine Environmental Trust Fund license plate program to raise money for capital improvements and 18 maintenance and repairs at existing state parks and historic sites, the Maine Endangered and Nongame Wildlife Program and to 20 support the Highway Fund.

The Secretary of State, Division of Motor Vehicles, will 22 require additional Highway Fund allocations of \$334,988 and 24 **\$84,3**35 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively, to manufacture and issue approximately 50,000 pairs of environmental plates for fiscal year 1993-94 and 10,000 for fiscal year 26 These Highway Fund costs will be reimbursed by 1994-95. transfers to the Highway Fund from the Maine Environmental Trust 28 Fund in the amount of \$10 per set of plates during the first 2 30 years of the program. These amounts could change for the following 2 years depending upon consideration of a report by the 32 Secretary of State to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation on the status of the program and a funding 34 proposal to be submitted by January 15, 1996. The remaining environmental license contribution is retained by the Maine Environmental Trust Fund and allocated to specific programs. 36 This plate program will increase net revenues to the Highway Fund 38 and increase dedicated revenues to the Maine Environmental Trust The estimated increases of Highway Fund revenues are Fund. 40 \$500,000 and \$600,000 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively. The estimated increases of dedicated revenues to 42 the Maine Environmental Trust Fund are \$500,000 and \$600,000 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively.

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to administer the new Maine Environmental Trust Fund and dedicated programs. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

HOUSE AMENDMENT """ to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 222, L.D.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the name of the Maine State Parks Capital Improvement Fund to the Maine State Parks Fund and 4 specifies that the fund may be used for maintenance, operations and repair costs in addition to capital improvements. It changes б the distribution of money from the Maine Environmental Trust Fund 8 with the Maine State Parks Fund receiving 60% and the Maine Endangered and Nongame Wildlife Fund receiving 40% of the balance 10 after reimbursement for costs. The Commissioner of Conservation is included in the group determining the registration plate 12 design. Reimbursement to the Secretary of State is set at \$10 per set of plates for the first 2 years. The Secretary of 14 State's report to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation must include legislation to implement their recommendation for 16 reimbursement after the first 2 years.
