Reimbursement for production and issuance costs. The 22 Treasurer of State shall transfer annually from the Maine Environmental Trust Fund to the Secretary of State \$10 for each 24 set of environmental registration plates issued or renewed. SENATE AMENDMENT 'X " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 222, L.D. 693

This bill establishes a Maine Environmental Trust Fund 2 license plate program to raise money for the protection of habitat and open space and to support the Highway Fund and other dedicated revenue programs. 4

6 The Secretary of State, Division of Motor Vehicles, will require additional Highway Fund allocations of \$357,788 and \$104,685 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively, to 8 manufacture and issue approximately 54,000 pairs of environmental 10 plates for fiscal year 1993-94 and 13,500 for fiscal year 1994-95. These Highway Fund costs will be reimbursed by transfers to the Highway Fund from the Maine Environmental Trust 12 Fund in the amount of \$10 per set of plates. The remaining environmental license contribution is retained by the Maine 14 Environmental Trust Fund and allocated to specific programs. This plate program will increase net revenues to the Highway Fund 16 and increase dedicated revenues to the Maine Environmental Trust The estimated increases of Highway Fund revenues are 18 Fund. \$540,000 and \$675,000 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, 20 respectively. The estimated increases of dedicated revenues to the Maine Environmental Trust Fund are \$540,000 and \$675,000 in 22 fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively.

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to administer the new Maine Environmental Trust Fund and dedicated programs. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes the provision lowered that reimbursement for production and issuance costs after the first 2 34 years of this plate program. The amendment provides for the funding split to continue at \$10 for the Secretary of State and \$10 to the Environmental Trust Fund. The amendment also replaces the fiscal note.
