An Act to Repeal the Sterilization Procedures Review Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§67, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 786, §5, is repealed.
 - Sec. 2. 34-B MRSA §7014, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 459, §7, is amended to read:

1. Confidentiality of proceedings and records. All court 10 proceedings occurring under this chapter shall---be are confidential and closed to the public, unless the person seeking sterilization or being considered for sterilization, personally 12 or through his an attorney, requests that the proceedings be open 14 to the public. Records of the court proceedings shall are not be open to inspection by the public, -- except -- under -- section -- 7917, without the consent, personally or through his an attorney, of 16 the person seeking sterilization or for whom sterilization is 18 being considered.

Sec. 3. 34-B MRSA §7017, as amended by PL 1985, c. 295, §50, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the Sterilization Procedures Review Committee. The need for the committee has ceased to exist along with the cases it was established to review. The very active 30 role of probate courts through guardianship in ensuring the rights of persons with mental illness or mental retardation has clearly played a role in the lack of need for the committee.

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
