HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "" to S.P. 240, L.D. 733, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Protective Custody"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the 20 title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and 24 before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 34-B MRSA §3861, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 459, §7, is amended to read:

A. May receive for observation, diagnosis, care and treatment in the hospital any person whose admission is applied for under section 3831  $e_{\pm}$ -3863; and

Sec. 2. 34-B MRSA §3861, sub-§2, ¶B, as amended by PL 1993, c. 34 336, §1, is further amended to read:

B. May receive for observation, --diagnosis, care and treatment in the hospital any person whose admission is applied for under section <u>3863 or</u> 3864 or is ordered by a court; and

Sec. 3. 34-B MRSA §3861, sub-§2, ¶C is enacted to read:

C. Shall receive for observation and diagnosis any person 44 whose admission is applied for under section 3863 or 3864.'

## 'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation will require additional General Fund appropriations and Other Special Revenue allocations to support the staffing and other costs associated with receiving additional people for observation and diagnosis at the 2 mental health facilities. The exact amounts can not be determined at this time.' '
