HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 558, L.D. 755, Bill, "An Act to Improve Access to Pharmaceuticals for Rural Health Center Patients"

Amend the amendment in section 6 in that part designated "§13802." in subsection 1 by inserting after paragraph A the following:

'B. A retail pharmacy shall offer drugs to all consumers with all the rights and privileges offered or given by that pharmacy to the most favored consumer. A retail pharmacy shall offer rebates, free merchandise and samples on proportionally equal terms to every consumer.'
