Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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3 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1325, as amended by PL 1991, c. 810, §33, is
4 further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

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A violation of this chapter is prima facie evidence of a
violation of the Maine Unfair Trade Practices Act in an action
limited to equitable relief.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill makes a violation of the Lead Poisoning Control
Act prima facie evidence of an unfair trade practice in a court
action that is limited to seeking equitable relief.
