

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §19205, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1989, 502, Pt.
A, §22, is repealed.

6 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §19205, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

8 2-A. Consolidation of AIDS funds. To the extent permitted
10 by federal funding sources, the Bureau of Health within the
12 Department of Human Services shall administer all federal and
14 state AIDS funds with the exception of AIDS funds within the
16 Department of Education. The bureau shall ensure coordination of
18 new and existing services and education to meet the needs of
20 persons with AIDS and HIV infection and shall identify gaps in
22 programs. The Department of Education shall manage its AIDS
24 funds but shall comply with mandates put forth by the Bureau of
Health as part of its coordinating function.

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 The purpose of this bill is to consolidate funds for AIDS
24 services and education in the State.
