COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 577, L.D. 781, Bill, "An Act to Introduce Greater Efficiency in the Provision of Certain State Services"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

**Sec. 2. Report.** Using fiscal year 1992-93 data, each department or agency of State Government is required to report to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs by June 1, 1993 listing the services provided to the public at no cost or without a means test; the expenditures, identified by funding source, made to support those services; the number of participants receiving those services or some other reliable measurement of service utilization; and the reasons a fee-for-service, copay or income test is not applied.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The costs associated with analyzing services provided to the public can be absorbed by the affected departments and agencies utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment clarifies the data that must be submitted to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs, adds a reporting date and adds a fiscal note.
