Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2802, first ¶, as amended by PL 1985, c. 194, is further amended to read:

6 There is created a board of trustees for the academy consisting of 15 17 members as follows: The the Commissioner of Public Safety, ex officior; the Attorney General, ex officior; 8 the Game Warden Colonel in the Department of Inland Fisheries and 10 Wildlife and the Commissioner of Corrections, ex officior; and the following to be appointed by the Governor: A <u>a</u> commissioned 12 officer of the State Police, a county sheriff, a chief of a municipal police department, 2 officers of municipal police departments, an educator, a representative from a criminal 14 justice agency not involved in the general enforcement of Maine 16 criminal laws, a representative of a federal law enforcement a citizen, a municipal officer, a county jail agency, 18 administrator, a county jail correctional officer and one nonsupervisory corrections officer representing a state er-eeunty 20 correctional facility.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the composition of the Board of Directors
of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy by adding to the board a
county jail administrator and a county jail correctional officer.

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
