HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 587, L.D. 791, Bill, "An Act to Eliminate the Prescription Requirement for Hypodermic Syringes"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§13787-A." by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Immunity limited. This section does not limit prosecution for violation of any law prohibiting or regulating the use, possession, dispensing, distribution or promotion of controlled substances, scheduled drugs or drug paraphernalia.'
