HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 263,
L.D. 801, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Charter of the
Lewiston-Auburn Water Pollution Control Authority"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the
following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local
units of government to expand or modify activities so as to
necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does
not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures.
Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,
two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have
determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph in the
first line (page 1, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following:
'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the
fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes a new Class E crime. Sentences
imposed for Class E offenses must be served in a county jail.
The average cost per sentence for a Class E crime is \$4,188 based
upon an average length of stay of 67 days. The additional costs
to the counties for the housing of each offender sentenced under
this new crime will not require reimbursement by the State.
