

**An Act to Reduce the Registration Fee on Small Hazardous Waste
Generators.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §2311, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1991, c. 520, §22, is further amended to read:

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1. **Hazardous waste generators.** All owners or operators of facilities that generate hazardous waste other than households and agricultural activities shall register annually with the commissioner. Registration forms and the accompanying fee are due to the commissioner by March 1, 1991 and annually thereafter. For facilities that generate 100 kilograms or more of hazardous waste in a calendar month for more than 3 months of the year, the fee is \$100 per facility. For all other generators, the fee is \$50 ~~\$50~~ \$25 per facility.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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Under current law, facilities that generate less than 100 kilograms of hazardous waste in a calendar month pay an annual fee of \$50. This bill changes the annual fee to \$25.
