COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 615, L.D. 830, Bill, "An Act Amending the Charter of the Brewer Water District"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting after the emergency clause the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenues by a minor amount.

The additional costs to enforce the water quality violations can be absorbed by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The bill alters the tax exempt status of the district. This amendment strikes that portion of the bill, preserving the current tax exempt status of the district.

This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
