HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 615, L.D. 830, Bill, "An Act Amending the Charter of the Brewer Water District"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "Sec. 14-A." in the 6th and 7th lines (page 1, lines 44 and 45 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "boating, fishing or swimming" and inserting in its place the following: 'boating or fishing'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "Sec. 14-B." in the first line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", swim" and in the 4th line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "boating" the following: ', swimming'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the restriction that would have banned swimming on all of Hatcase Pond. The amendment clarifies that swimming, along with boating and fishing, will be banned anywhere within 2,000 feet of the intake of the Brewer Water District.
