

An Act Regarding Certification Fees for Adult Education Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13007, sub-§1**, as enacted by PL 1991, c.
4 591, Pt. I, §5, is amended to read:

6 **1. Fees.** The commissioner shall assess fees for initial
7 teacher, education specialist and administrator certificates and
8 for the renewal of inactive provisional and professional teacher,
9 education specialist and administrator certificates. The fee is
10 \$50 for the initial certification process for those teachers and
11 education specialists found eligible and those found ineligible.
12 A renewal fee of \$50 must be assessed for each inactive teacher
13 and education specialist. The fee is \$100 for the initial
14 certification process for those administrators found eligible and
15 those found ineligible. A renewal fee of \$100 must be assessed
16 for each inactive administrator. Notwithstanding this
17 subsection, there is no fee for adult education teachers.

20 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

22 Under current law, the certification fees for adult
23 education teachers are the same as regular full-time teachers.
24 The purpose of this bill is to reconcile the difference in
25 earnings between regular full-time teachers and adult education
26 teachers by eliminating the fee for the certification of adult
education teachers.
