20	'2. Contingent fund. There is established a contingent account in each county in an amount not to exceed \$50,000
22	annually, except in Sagadahoc County where the contingent account may not exceed 4% of the annual budget. Notwithstanding the
24	preceding sentence, a county, by unanimous action of the county
26	commissioners, may increase the contingent account limit to an amount not exceeding \$100,000. Any funds that are available to
	each county may be used for this purpose. This fund may be used
28	at the discretion of the county commissioners for emergency purposes only, except that if a county increases the contingent
30	account limit as authorized in the 2nd sentence of this
32	subsection, expenditures from the account above \$50,000 must be approved by a majority of the county legislative delegation if

## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 286, L.D. 856

commissioners for emergency purposes. This amendment authorizes counties to raise the limit on the contingent account to \$100,000 and changes the approval process for use of additional funds in the account if it does so. The amendment requires that all expenditures from the contingent account in excess of the previous \$50,000 limit must be approved by majority vote of the legislative delegation or the county budget or finance committee.
