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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment replaces the exemption from access provision in the original bill with a procedure permitting waivers or variances from construction standards if compliance is not technologically feasible or will result in excessive and unreasonable costs without any substantive benefit to persons with physical disabilities. The procedure is available for public accommodations built, renovated, remodeled or enlarged between September 1, 1974 and January 1, 1991, and application for the waiver or variance must be made before September 30, 1994.
