An Act Concerning Renewal Registration of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §106, first ¶, as amended by PL 1989, c. 866, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §26, is further amended to read:

The Except as provided in subsection 2, paragraph B, the 6 registration year for all vehicles, except automobiles, newly 8 acquired motor trucks, truck tractors, motorcycles, mopeds, motor-driven cycles and motor homes is from March 1st to the last 10 day of February of the next calendar year. On and after February lst, it is lawful to use and display on such those vehicles the 12 number plates or suitable devices in lieu thereof issued for the shall---apply applies registration year. Thissection to 14 motorcycles, mopeds and motor-driven cycles for reregistration in 1989 only.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §106, sub-§2, ¶B, as amended by PL 1991, c. 18 44, §3, is further amended to read:

B. Except as provided in this section, when application for registration of an automobile, motor truck, truck tractor, motorcycle, moped, motor-driven cycle, motor home or camp trailer is made after the registration for the previous year has been expired for more than 30 days, the expiration date of the renewal is at the end of the month, one year from the month of issuance of the previous registration. If the applicant provides satisfactory evidence and certifies in writing to the Secretary of State that the vehicle has not been operated on a public way during the period of the expired registration, the registration expiration date, upon renewal, is at the end of the month one year from the month of issuance of the registration renewal.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the laws on motor vehicle registration to add language that was removed in Public Law 1987, chapter 117. Under this bill, if an applicant for registration certifies that a motor vehicle has not been operated on a public way during the period of the expired registration, then the renewal registration is for one year from the month that renewal registration is issued.
