An Act Related to the State Valuation of the Town of Limestone.

(EMERGENCY)

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27. Reference to the Committee on Taxation suggested and ordered printed.

Cosponsored by Senator PARADIS of Aroostook and Representatives: CAMPBELL of Holden, DiPIETRO of South Portland, MURPHY of Berwick, TARDY of Palmyra, Senator: KIEFFER of Aroostook. **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the impending closure of Loring Air Force Base has had a catastrophic impact on property values in the Town of Limestone; and

Whereas, the announcement of the closure of Loring Air Force Base occurred within the period during which the State calculated the most recent valuation for Limestone; and

Whereas, this announcement effectively brought to a halt all 14 property sales in the Town of Limestone thereby exaggerating the effect of preclosure announcement sales in the State's valuation; 16 and

18 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 20 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 22 safety; now, therefore,

24 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Adjustment of 1992 state valuation for Town of Limestone.
The 1992 state valuation of the Town of Limestone is reduced by
\$6,600,000 to \$34,650,000.

30 Sec. 2. Adjustments. The Treasurer of State shall adjust revenue-sharing payments from the Local state-municipal 32 Government Fund for fiscal year 1992-93 to provide the appropriate total fiscal year 1992-93 allocations to various 34 municipalities in the State due to the adjustment to the 1992 state valuation of the Town of Limestone as provided in this Act. 36

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.
