An Act to Change the Wording on Maine State Automobile License Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §110, first ¶, as amended by PL 1991, c. 597, §6, is further amended to read:

The Secretary of State shall furnish suitable number plates, seals and other distinguishing marks, without charge, to every person, except dealers, manufacturers and holders of transporter registration plates, whose vehicle is registered under this Title. These plates must be of a distinctly different color or shade each year and must be in the form the Secretary of State determines. The plates must bear the numerals of the year of issue or the last 2 numerals of that year, the word "Maine" or the abbreviation "Me." in letters not less than 3/4 inch in height, and on plates issued for passenger vehicles for private use and trucks, there must be placed at the bottom of the plates in letters not less than 3/4 inch in height the word "Vagationland." words "MAINE/FOR ALL SEASONS." The numerals of the register number on the plates, except on motorcycle number plates, may not be substantially less than 3 inches high. Number plates issued for temporary or special classes of registration must contain a distinguishing letter, mark or design selected by the Secretary of State. A vehicle required to be registered in a special class under this Title may display only the number plates designed for that special class of registration.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §131, 3rd ¶, as amended by PL 1991, c. 597, $\S7$, is further amended to read:

The following design elements are guidelines that must be 30 followed by the Secretary of State in the production of new plates issued beginning July 1987. A new plate must have a white 32 background, identification numbers and letters and the border 34 must be distinctly navy blue in color with any graphic material. appearing in a color distinctly lobster red, featuring an illustration of a lobster. The name of the State "Maine" must 36 appear centered at the top of the plate and the designation "Vacationland" "MAINE/FOR ALL SEASONS" must appear centered at 38 the bottom. This guidance is meant to be applied in accordance 40 with the authority held by the Secretary of State in section 110.

Sec. 3. 29 MRSA §242, sub-§1, ¶A, as amended by PL 1991, c. 793, §6 and affected by §13, is further amended to read:

Α. The fee for motor vehicles used for the conveyance of passengers is \$22. The fee for motor vehicles used interchangeably for the conveyance of passengers or property is \$22. These vehicles must be designated as "combinations" and may \mathbf{be} issued а special plate with the word "Combination" in lieu of "Vacationland." "MAINE/FOR ALL

<u>SEASONS."</u> Passenger vehicles used under contract with the State, a municipality or a school district to transport students must be designated as "combinations." Vehicles owned or operated by parents or legal guardians are exempt from this provision. Commercial plates may not be issued to or displayed on automobiles.

Motor vehicles used for the conveyance of passengers operated exclusively on islands having no roads maintained or supported by the State must be registered for a fee of \$2 and the municipality collecting excise tax for these vehicles may collect an additional fee of \$4 to defray the cost of removing abandoned vehicles.

For the purpose of registration only, a pickup truck may be registered as provided for automobiles, provided that at no time may the gross weight of a pickup truck so registered exceed 6,000 pounds when used as a motor truck or truck tractor. The owner of such a pickup truck desiring a gross weight of the truck in excess of 6,000 pounds must register the truck as provided in section 246.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the wording on Maine license plates from "Vacationland" to "MAINE/FOR ALL SEASONS."
