SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
295, L.D. 881, Bill, "An Act Regarding Lobbying"


Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of
subsection 4 (page 1, lines 22 to 26 in amendment) and inserting
in its place the following:

'4. Former Legislator. A former Legislator may not act as
a lobbyist for one year following termination of the Legislator's
term of office. As used in this subsection, "lobbyist" has the
same meaning as in Title 3, section 312-A, subsection 10.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to narrow the group of
people to whom the prohibition in Committee Amendment "A" applies
to those former Legislators acting as lobbyists.
