

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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4       **Sec. 1. Department waiver request.** The Department of Human  
6       Services shall apply within 30 days of the effective date of this  
8       Act to the federal Department of Health and Human Services for a  
10       waiver under the Medicaid program to provide home-based care  
12       services for persons with HIV/AIDS. The department shall notify  
14       the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources by January 15,  
16       1994 of the status of the waiver application.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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16       This bill requires the Department of Human Services to apply  
for a waiver under the Medicaid program to cover home-based care  
services for the persons with HIV/AIDS.

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
