COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 664, L.D. 902, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Role of the Child Abuse and Neglect Councils"

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "§3873." in subsection 2 in the 7th and 8th lines (page 3, lines 1 and 2 in L.D.) by striking out all of the following: "child abuse and neglect councils in each county." and inserting in its place the following: 'child abuse and neglect councils in each county as resources permit. Nothing in this chapter requires the department to fully fund the activities of any child abuse and neglect council.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that, although the bill requires that each county have a child abuse and neglect council, it does not require the Department of Human Services to fully fund each council's activities.
