SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 665, L.D. 903, Bill, "An Act to Bring the Bureau of State Police, the Department of the Attorney General and the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency into Conformity with the Criminal History Record Information Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 10 and 11 and inserting in their place the following:

Sec. 10. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.


