SENATE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{B} " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 665, L.D. 903

The Department of the Attorney General will incur additional annual costs of approximately of \$60,000 beginning in fiscal year 1995-96. The bill limits the amount of additional General Fund appropriations that the department may receive for this purpose to the amount of additional revenue. The net cost of \$40,000 must be absorbed by the department utilizing existing resources.'

This amendment permits the Attorney General to establish a fee for access to and copying of records. Costs of access and copying that are not covered by fees must be covered by existing resources. No additional funds may be appropriated from the General Fund for this purpose. The amendment removes the appropriation section, adds an effective date and replaces the fiscal note.
