SENATE AMENDMENT " ${\cal B}$ " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 666, L.D. 904, Bill, "An Act to Protect Maine Citizens From the Effects of Environmental Tobacco Smoke"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title and before 18 the first indented paragraph the following:

20 'Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$1541.</u>" in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>2 persons</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>one person</u>' '

Further amend the amendment in the first indented paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 28 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd indented paragraphs (page 1, lines 22 to 30 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 4th 34 indented paragraph the following:

36 'Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$1542.</u>" in subsection 2 in paragraph E (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) 38 by inserting at the end the following: '<u>If public employees'</u> rights provided in collective bargaining agreements are affected 40 by this section, the employees have the right to reopen negotiations for the purpose of bargaining for smoking areas in 42 nonpublic areas of publicly owned buildings.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated, "<u>§1542.</u>" in subsection 2 in paragraph G in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 24 and 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>or other facilities serving primarily alcohol"</u> '

Further amend the amendment in the 5th indented paragraph in the 5th line (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the 2 following: "when all persons present in the office consent" 4 Further amend the amendment in the 6th indented paragraph by striking out all of paragraph K and inserting in its place the б following: 8 'K. Smoking is not prohibited in public places when beano or bingo games are being conducted in accordance with the 10 provisions of Title 17, sections 314 and 314-A. 12 L. Smoking is not prohibited in a retail store under 2,000 square feet that primarily sells tobacco or tobacco-related 14 products. 16 M. Smoking is not prohibited on privately chartered buses.' 18 Further amend the amendment by inserting before the 7th indented paragraph the following: 20 'Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated 22 "<u>§1542.</u>" by striking out all of subsection 3. 24 Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated ."<u>§1542.</u>" by renumbering the sections to read consecutively. 26 . 28 Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "**\$1578-B**" in subsection 4 in the 3rd line (page 3, line 38 in L.D) by inserting after the word "board" the following: 'or 30 school employees' and by inserting after the word "establish" the 32 following: 'through collective bargaining' ' 34 STATEMENT OF FACT 36 This amendment accomplishes the following. 38 1. The amendment removes the definition of tavern or lounge and clarifies that the prohibition does not apply to taverns or 40 lounges. 42 2. The amendment exempts from the prohibition a private 44 office that consists of an enclosed work area for one person. The amendment deletes the provision regarding minimum 46 З. standards. 48

4. The amendment enacts exemptions for smoke shops and chartered buses.

5. The amendment clarifies that school boards and school employees retain collective bargaining rights with respect to the establishment of designated smoking areas.

6. The amendment preserves collective bargaining rights for public employees by incorporating into the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 1542, subsection 2, paragraph E language found currently in Title 22, section 1578-A, subsection 4.
