

Sec. 1. Department of Administrative and Financial Services duties.

2 **Resolved:** That the Department of Administrative and Financial
Services shall:

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6 1. Prepare a plan that reduces the State Government work
force by 25%. The plan must be based on the total number of
8 administrative and nonadministrative personnel employed in State
Government as of January 1, 1993. The plan must specifically
10 detail each position to be abolished and specify the amount of
savings to be achieved, by funding source, as a result of the
reduction in personnel;

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14 2. Consult with the heads of all departments and agencies
in State Government to ensure that no program or service to the
16 public is completely eliminated due to the reduction of state
personnel; and

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20 3. Report its plan, together with any necessary
implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on
Appropriations and Financial Affairs no later than November 1,
1993.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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28 This resolve directs the Department of Administrative and
Financial Services to develop a plan to reduce the State
Government work force by 25%.
