2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

6 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the
beginning of the next fiscal year; and

8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the
operation of the Department of Environmental Protection become
10 due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1993; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety; now, therefore,

18 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

20 **Sec. 1. Allocation of the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund.** Income
to the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund for the next 2 fiscal
22 years, from July 1, 1993 to June 30, 1994 and from July 1, 1994
to June 30, 1995, must be segregated, apportioned and disbursed
24 as designated in the following schedule.

12 **Sec. 5. Adjustments to allocations.** Allocations made in sections
 14 1 to 4 of this Act may be increased or adjusted by the State
 Budget Officer, with the approval of the Governor, to
 16 specifically cover those adjustments determined necessary under
 any salary plan approved by the Legislature and those
 18 reclassifications or range changes that have been approved by the
 Department of Administrative and Financial Services and submitted
 20 for legislative review prior to the effective date of this Act.

22 **Sec. 6. Encumbered balance at year end.** At the end of each
 fiscal year, all encumbered balances may not be carried forward
 24 more than once.

26 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
 preamble, this Act takes effect July 1, 1993.
