

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §274-A, sub-§7, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1991, c.
4 579, §11, is amended to read:

B. Races conducted outside the State may be simulcast to an
off-track betting facility within the State ~~only if these~~
8 ~~racess--are--being--simulcast--to--the--off-track--betting~~
~~licensee's--racetrack--at--the--same--time~~ from a licensed
10 commercial track as approved by the commission.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill allows commercial tracks to simulcast to off-track
betting sites without races being conducted at the race track at
18 the same time.
