HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 307,
L.D. 940, Bill, "An Act to Minimize Electric Rates"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 1, in
paragraph H by inserting at the end the following: 'Nothing in
the consideration of any such rate levels may be construed to
compel a disproportionate increase in rates to residential
customers with usage of 500 or fewer kilowatt hours.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment ensures that incremental use rates do not
automatically result in increases to the vast majority of
residential users.
