HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 307,
L.D. 940, Bill, "An Act to Minimize Electric Rates"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end of section 3 the
following:

'As a result of giving equal consideration to the goals of
minimizing costs and minimizing rates or in approving any
proposals for rates that allow incremental use or maintenance of
existing use pursuant to this Act, the Public Utilities
Commission may not adopt any rate design that results increased
rates for residential customers with usage of less than 750
kilowatt hours per month. Nothing in the preceding sentence may
be construed to prohibit the Public Utilities Commission from
increasing rates for residential customers with usage of less
than 750 kilowatt hours per month to the extent justified by
other legitimate rational principles or legislative mandates.'
