An Act to Promote Fair Contract Bidding.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1825-B, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Proof required. Any bid submitted under this chapter must be accompanied by proof that the bidder has workers' compensation and employers' liability insurance coverage as required by Title 39-A and has made all payments to the Unemployment Compensation Fund required by Title 26, chapter 13. Failure to submit the required proof disgualifies a bidder from consideration for the contract. Submission of false proof is a Class D crime and results in recision and reopening by the State of the contract for which the false information was submitted.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill requires persons bidding on a state contract to submit proof of workers' compensation coverage and payment of 20 unemployment compensation fees. A bidder who fails to submit the required proof is disqualified from the bidding process. 22 Submission of false information is a Class D crime and results in reopening any contract for which false information was submitted.
