Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6203-A is enacted to read:
§6203-A. Delayed payment
If a claimant is determined eligible under this program and
that claimant's payment will be delayed by more than 30 days, the
State Tax Assessor shall notify the claimant in writing of the
fact that the payment will be delayed, the reason for the delay
and the date when payment can be expected.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill requires the State Tax Assessor to notify an
eligible claimant for the Maine Residents Property Tax Program if
that person's payment will be delayed. The State Tax Assessor
must explain why the payment is delayed and project a date when
the payment can be expected.
