HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 740, L.D. 998, Bill, "An Act to Promote Proper Animal Health Care and to Regulate the Purchase and Sale of Hypodermic Needles and Syringes"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Promote Proper Animal Health Care'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional costs to administer an expanded definition of biological products that need approval prior to sale. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes those portions of the bill amending the laws regulating hypodermic apparatus, such as needles and syringes.
