

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §702-A is enacted to read:

6 §702-A. Process by private investigator or bonded security agency

8 A private investigator or a bonded security agency licensed
10 by the State may serve and execute all writs and precepts
12 required under this subchapter.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill authorizes a licensed private investigator or a bonded security agency to serve and execute civil processes.
