1. Filing. The lien shall-attach attaches to all nonexempt real and personal property of the responsible parent or a stepparent, if the stepparent's property has been used to secure any debts of the responsible parent, when the department files, in the registry of deeds of any county or with any office appropriate for a notice with respect to personal property, a certificate which that states the name and address of the responsible parent, his-address or stepparent, the amount of the child support debt accrued, the date of the decision or notice of debt by which the debt was assessed and the name and address of the authorized agent of the department who issues the lien.

This bill allows the Department of Human Services to place a lien on property of a stepparent for child support arrearage if the stepparent's property has been used to secure any debts of the delinquent parent.
