

E. The financial resources and needs of a party, including nonrecurring income not included in the definition of gross income, but excluding financial contributions from a spouse, domestic associate or relative that allow the parent to be unemployed or under-employed;

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts any financial contributions from a spouse or domestic associate beyond lodging fees from the criteria for deviating from child support guidelines.
