Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Notwithstanding this section or any other provision of law, the board may not establish by rule a low-emission vehicle program or a clean fuels program adopted by the State of California. Any such rule adopted prior to the effective date of this paragraph is repealed.

Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §585-A, as amended by PL 1989, c. 890, Pt. A, §40 and Pt. B, §159, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Notwithstanding this section or any other provision of law, the board may not establish by rule a low-emission vehicle program or a clean fuels program adopted by the State of California. Any such rule adopted prior to the effective date of this paragraph is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

26 The purpose of this bill is to remove the authority of the Board of Environmental Protection to adopt California's 28 low-emission vehicle program and California's clean fuels program.
