32	STATEMENT OF FACT
34	The Maine Health Care Finance Commission annually adjusts
	the financial requirements to which a hospital is entitled based
36	on a comparison of current hospital volume and volume budgeted
	for the base year. The Maine Health Care Finance Commission has
38	taken the position that it is not authorized to adjust a
	hospital's base-year volume statistic under the Maine Revised
40	Statutes, Title 22, section 396-D, subsection 9-A unless a very
	specific set of circumstances exists. This bill provides the
42	Maine Health Care Finance Commission with the authority to

rectify that situation in those cases when it is unable to do so

under Title 22, section 396-D, subsection 9-A by allowing the substitution of actual hospital volume in the base year for

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estimated base-year volume.
