

2 **Sec. 1. Study and report required. Resolved:** That the Bureau of
Taxation, in consultation with the Joint Standing Committee on
4 Taxation, shall conduct a study concerning taxation issues
involving seasonal residents. This study must examine the
6 economic impact of nonresidents who reside in this State for part
of the year and must address the feasibility of imposing a tax on
8 the income of any nonresident individual who resides for a
portion of the year in this State. The Bureau of Taxation shall
10 submit its report, together with any necessary implementing
legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 116th
Legislature no later than November 1, 1993.
