

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §4641-B, 5th ¶, as amended by PL 1983, c. 859,
Pt. M, §10, is further amended to read:

6 Each register of deeds shall, on or before the 10th day of
8 each month, pay over to the State Tax Assessor 90% 75% of the tax
collected during the previous month. The Of the remaining 10%
10 shall 25%, 1/2 must be retained for the county ~~by the register of~~
~~deeds and accounted for to the county treasurer as reimbursement~~
12 for services rendered by the county in collecting the tax and 1/2
must be retained for the account of the county sheriff to provide
and oversee court security.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the percentage of real estate transfer
taxes delivered to the State Tax Assessor and requires that 1/2
of the amount retained is applied to the account of the county
sheriff to provide and oversee court security.
