HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 777,
L.D. 1050, Bill, "An Act to Repeal the Laws Allowing State
Agencies to Adopt Rules Having the Force of Law"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated
"§11117." by striking out subsection 1 and inserting in its place
the following:

'1. Meetings. While the Legislature is in regular or
special session, the committee may meet to conduct the review
upon the vote of a majority of the committee. When the
Legislature is not in session, the committee may meet as approved
by the Legislative Council.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment limits committee meetings to review rules
when the Legislature is not in session to meetings approved by
the Legislative Council.
