COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 779, L.D. 1052, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Mechanism for Ensuring Adequate Preservation and Maintenance of the State House"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 12-A in the 9th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "achieved." the following: 'The State Controller is further authorized to transfer from the Reserve Fund for State House Preservation and Maintenance to the Blaine House Renovations and Repairs Fund such amounts as recommended by the Legislative Council.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 12-A in the 16th line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "allocation and" and inserting in its place the following: 'allocation.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 12-A in the 18th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and upon" and inserting in its place the following: ', must be reviewed and recommended by the State House and Capitol Park Commission and must receive'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

If unexpended balances of General Fund appropriations to the Legislature are transferred to the Reserve Fund for State House Preservation and Maintenance, the amount of the balance that would be carried forward into a subsequent fiscal year would be reduced.'
